### Action Taken Report (2018-19)

The Feedback survey among the major stakeholders like Students, Teachers, Alumni and Employers was conducted through offline feedback forms and online via Google Forms by considering the feasibility of upgrading the curriculum. The received feedback data were thoroughly analyzed by the members of IQAC and necessary actions were suggested to the members in the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of IQAC held on November 30, 2019.

Major summary to note in Feedback:

1. More than 60% of students participated in feedback for academic purposes.
2. Academic feedback was taken twice in a year.
3. 30 employers participated in feedback during recruitment drives in the session
4. More than 48% of faculties have provided feedback for academic and resources of the Institute.
5. More than 40% of the Alumni have participated in Alumni Feedback during Alumni Meet.
6. Students are well satisfied with the curriculum development.

Following the same, the ATR's of the Feedback were received by IQAC from all the office bearers and the compiled report was presented in the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of IQAC dated February 14, 2020. The detailed report of ATR is attached here with.

S. No.	Feedback Suggestions	Action Taken
1	Requirement of Value Added Courses as per the latest needs of Industry	Value Added courses are organized like VAC on IBM BI, Value Added course on IBM Cloud, Value Added Course on IBM IOT.
2	More placement opportunities and information on future career options to support the placements	Expert Sessions on Placement opportunities were conducted for students. Mock Tests and Mock Drives were conducted to give them exposure to placement drives for their career.
3	Need of bridging the gap between theory and practical and more opportunities for field experiences	Hands-on learning, skill development, and more professionally oriented programmes like Android, programming languages and Web Development sessions conducted to fill the gap and provide experience of latest technological developments to students.
4	Improvement in the quality of Induction Program should be increased	Interactive Orientation session organized for students like session on, language and communication skill ,yoga sessions, Human values sessions etc.
5	Quality Improvement in Teaching and learning activities	Sessions were conducted for the faculty members such as FDP on Quality Improvement in the Teaching Learning Process and Quality enhancement program.
6	More Industrial Visits should be increased	Management allowed taking students for Industry Visit in each session for more understanding of Industry.
7	There should be more skill and Research based activities	In every semester a student will undergo a Non-Syllabus Project in which he/she has to make a latest technology based project. Additionally in Final Year Seminar it is now compulsory for each student to write a Review Paper on the Seminar topic and get it published.
