
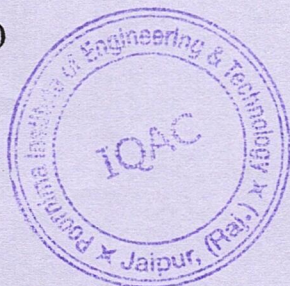



Action Taken Report on Resolutions of the 27th IQAC Meeting (Held on March 18, 2025)

S. No.	Resolution	Action Taken
1	IQAC proposed applying for UGC Autonomous Status and recommended constituting a dedicated team with a defined timeline.	Following IQAC's recommendation, a dedicated committee was constituted to oversee the UGC Autonomous Status application. A detailed timeline and work plan were developed, and responsibilities were assigned to ensure systematic preparation and timely submission of the application.
2	IQAC reviewed the Odd Semester 2024-25 feedback, identified areas for improvement, and directed all departments to implement corrective measures to ensure continuous enhancement of academic and administrative quality.	All departments have reviewed the directives issued by IQAC based on the Odd Semester 2024-25 feedback. Corrective measures have been implemented in the identified areas, and ongoing monitoring is being carried out to ensure continuous improvement of academic and administrative quality.
3	The IQAC recommended focused improvements in teaching strategies, curriculum delivery, and student performance monitoring to uphold and enhance academic excellence.	Departments implemented IQAC recommendations by improving teaching strategies, curriculum delivery, and student performance monitoring to ensure sustained academic excellence.
4	The IQAC recommended aligning objectives with DAB and PAC, clarifying OBE goals, and assigning faculty responsibilities to support continuous improvement.	Departments aligned objectives with DAB and PAC, clarified OBE goals, strengthened strategic planning, and assigned responsibilities to faculty members.
5	IQAC suggested increasing student participation in NSS activities and aligning them with societal needs and institutional goals.	The NSS unit has initiated measures to boost student participation and ensure all activities are planned in alignment with societal needs and the institution's objectives.
6	IQAC suggested planning the mini convocation in detail and documenting best practices from AAROHAN 2024-25 for future events.	The degree distribution program (mini convocation) was planned and coordinated as per IQAC guidance, and best practices from AAROHAN 2024-25 have been documented for reference in future events.
